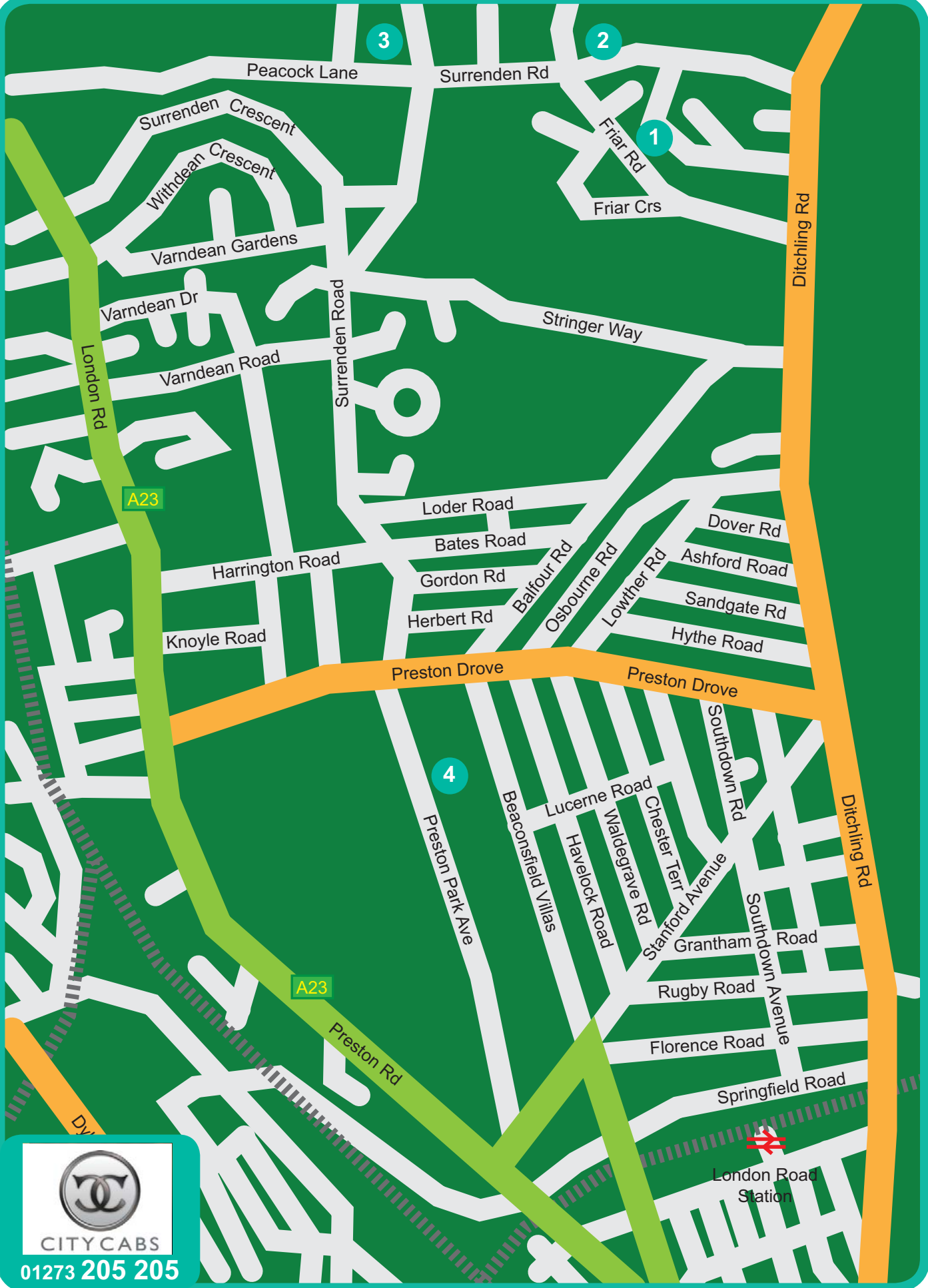

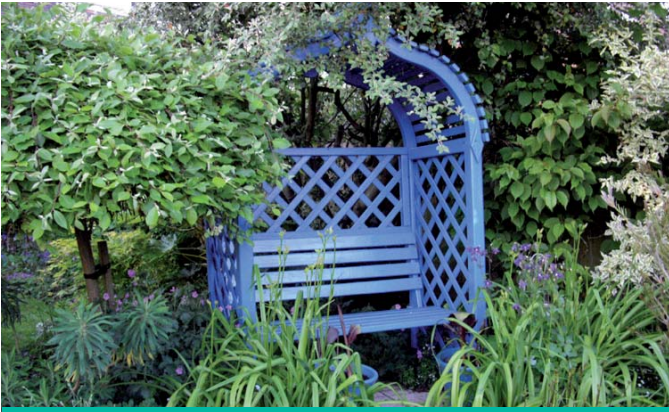

There are two small ponds, fruit trees and an over stocked greenhouse. the garden is maintained as organically as possible, especially in the fenced vegetable patch, which is home to five happy hens. Entry is by the side gate and tea and homemade cakes will be on sale.

The lawn is slowly being reclaimed from children's rugby and football to create beds and borders for a colourful variety of plants.
